

TTC Rosedale Station - Easier Access Project

Pre-construction information

Dear Neighbour,

Plans to make Rosedale Station accessible are nearing completion and construction is scheduled to begin in spring 2021, and be completed in 2025. There are 48 stations accessible thus far, with a commitment to completing the remaining stations by 2025, as required by the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act.

The new features at Rosedale Station include two elevators that will provide customers with an accessible path between the subway platform and street level. Other features include CCTV and updated signage. Details on the project, including design, accessibility features, impacts and mitigation are available on a dedicated project page where you will also find construction updates and notices when they are released.

I encourage you to visit the page and register for regular updates or simply contact me to be added to the project mailing list. Being added to the mailing list will also ensure that you receive notices in the event there are utility disruptions in the area during construction. Although all steps are taken to minimize disruptions, there are occasions where they are required in order to complete the project.

The station will remain open throughout construction, as will access to sidewalks and the path leading to the ravine.
