Watermain and Streetcar Track Renewal Queen Street East from Broadview Avenue to Davies Avenue

TTC diversions: As early as early November, until Spring 2026 *Content/timeline accurate at the time of printing

What we are doing and why

The City of Toronto will be replacing aging watermains on Queen Street East between Broadview Avenue and Davies Avenue, including Munro Street.

Following watermain work, the City and the TTC will renew the streetcar tracks on Queen Street East from Broadview Avenue and Davies Avenue. Visit the City's project webpage for further construction details including traffic management information: toronto.ca/QueenEastConstruction

As a result of these infrastructure upgrades, there will be TTC service adjustments to 501/301 Queen, 503 Kingston Rd and 504/304 King routes. *Diversions will begin once watermain construction begins.*

TTC rail delivery and storage

Before track work, the TTC plans to conduct preliminary rail welding and storage on Queen Street East, just east of River Street. The TTC will notify affected properties once details are confirmed.


TTC service

Starting Sunday, October 12:

- 504B/304 King streetcars will operate as far east as Distillery Loop
- 504 King and 301B Queen replacement buses will be introduced and operate between Broadview Station and King/Parliament

When watermain work starts, TTC service is planned to divert as follows:

- 501/301 Queen streetcars will divert both ways via Dundas Street East between Broadview Avenue and Parliament Street
- 503 Kingston Rd replacement buses will operate through the work area via Queen Street and Parliament Street. The entire route will run between Bingham Loop and the King Street and Joe Shuster Way area







• 504D King replacement buses will operate through the work area, operating between Broadview Station and King Street East and Parliament Street area



When TTC track work starts in 2026, TTC service is planned to divert as follows:

- 501/301 Queen streetcars will continue to divert both ways via Dundas Street East between Broadview Avenue and Parliament Street
- 504/304 King streetcars will continue to operate as far east as Distillery Loop
- 503 Kingston Rd and 504 King buses will continue to operate, however, buses will only run eastbound on Queen Street East through the work area
- Westbound buses will divert via Broadview Avenue, Dundas Street and River Street
- An updated notice will be shared prior to TTC track work.

Transit diversions are subject to change. Further service details will be shared on ttc.ca/QueenEast
