



College St and McCaul St Overhead Upgrades Mid-October 2025 to end of year

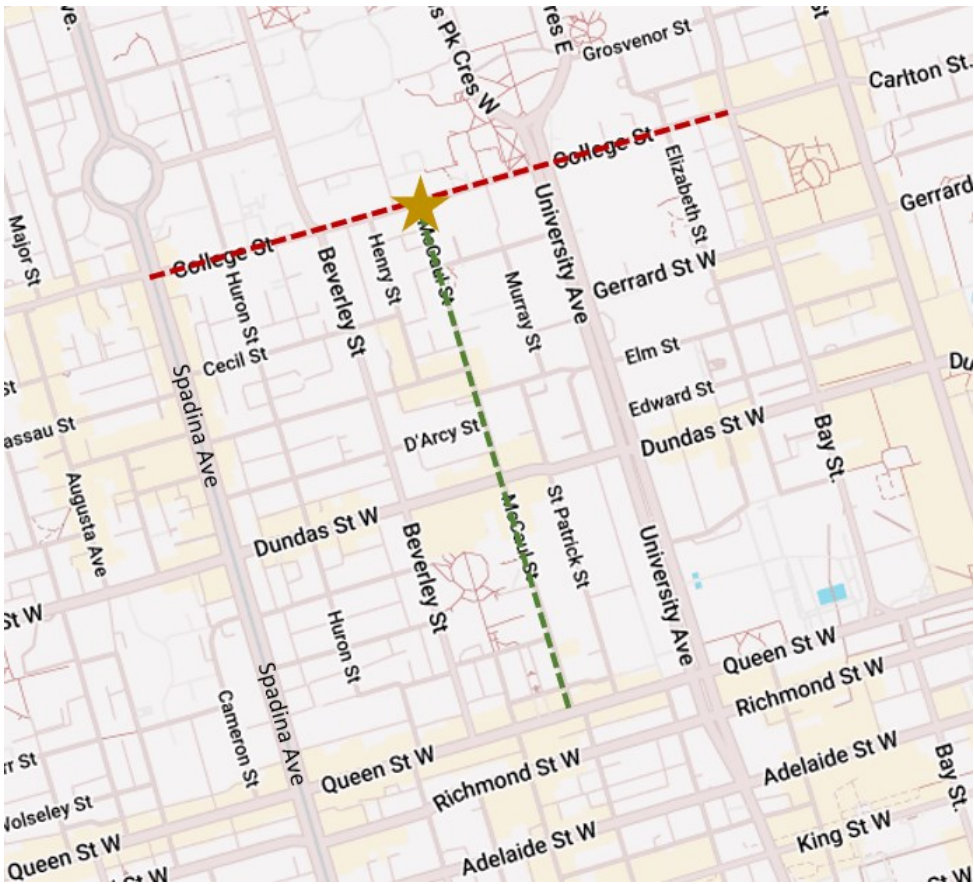

What we are doing and why

During the upcoming track renewal work at the intersection of College Street and McCaul Street, the TTC will take the opportunity to upgrade overhead infrastructure in the area as well.

From mid-October until the end of the year, crews will work at the following locations:

- **College Street (Spadina Avenue to Bay Street)**
- **McCaul Street (College Street to Queen Street West)**
- **College Street and McCaul Street Intersection:** Overhead work at this intersection will begin after track work is completed and the intersection is reopened.



Work activities, hours and locations

- To complete this work safely and efficiently, TTC overhead crews may work during the day and night as required.
- While they aim to deploy a moving work zone across College Street or McCaul Street, they require some flexibility. Given the right conditions, which include curb lane availability and access to overhead poles, they may move and work in different locations throughout the same day and week.

Equipment

TTC overhead trucks with hydraulic equipment will be used to carry out this work. While efforts will be made by the crew to keep noise to a minimum, beeping sounds when the trucks are backing up will be audible. Equipment lights may also be noticeable.

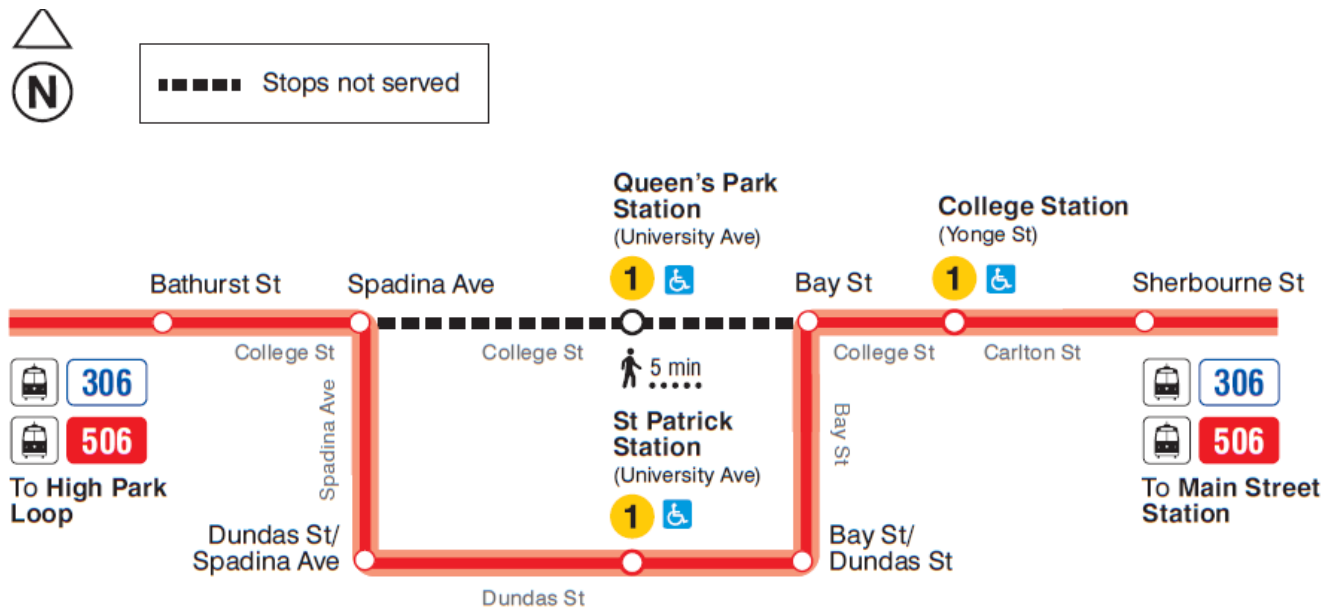

Motorist, cyclist, and pedestrian impacts

- Traffic will be maintained through the overhead work areas.
- Sidewalks will not be impacted.
- Parking may need to be temporarily restricted in local areas where crews are working and accessing overhead poles.

TTC service— Effective October 12, 2025



506 306 Carlton streetcars are scheduled to divert via Spadina Avenue, Dundas Street West, and Bay Street to regular routing.

Regular streetcar service is expected to resume once all work is completed by end of year.

94 Wellesley bus service will be increased and operate between Ossington and Castle Frank stations as an alternative east-west option.
