Streetcar Track Renewal at College and McCaul Transit diversions due to construction

TTC service changes: Starting as early as Sunday, October 12 until end of year Content/timeline accurate at the time of printing

What we are doing and why

Starting as early as Sunday, October 12, 2025 the City of Toronto and TTC will be renewing the streetcar tracks at the intersection of College Street and McCaul Street, requiring a temporary full road closure.

As a result of these infrastructure upgrades, 506 306 Carlton streetcars will be diverting around the area as early as Sunday, October 12.

TTC overhead upgrades

From mid-October until the end of the year, TTC will also use this opportunity to upgrade the overhead infrastructure in the area. Crews will work on College Street from Spadina Avenue to Bay Street, on McCaul Street from Queen Street to College Street, and at the intersection of College Street and McCaul Street.

Rail delivery and storage

During the first week of work, the TTC plans to deliver new streetcar rails on flatbed trailers and store them at or near the work zone. As new rail installation progresses, the flatbed trailers will be removed from site.
