Streetcar Track Renewal at College St. and McCaul St. Delivery and storage of new streetcar rail panels

Timeline: Friday, October 17 to Sunday, October 19, 2025 - nightly Content/timeline accurate at the time of printing

Rail Delivery and Storage Details

On Tuesday, October 14, 2025, the City of Toronto and the TTC will begin renewal of the streetcar track at the intersection of College Street and McCaul Street. To support this work, the TTC will deliver new streetcar rail panels to the site nightly from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., starting Friday, October 17 to Sunday, October 19.

The rail panels will be delivered on flat-deck trailers for eventual installation at the intersection. The flat-bed trailers will be parked in the centre lanes of College Street and McCaul Street intersection (please see map on the reverse for more details). The flat-bed trailers will be removed from the site as track work progresses and the new rail panels are installed.

Noise

- To move the rails safely and efficiently, a crew will deliver the rails overnight with traffic controls and a Toronto Police (TPS) escort.
- While crews will try to keep noise to a minimum during delivery, backup safety alarms on trucks and equipment will produce beeping sounds.
- Equipment lights will also be visible.

Travel Impacts

- The intersection of College and McCaul will be fully closed for construction as of October 14.
- For safety, traffic controls will be in place during rail delivery.
- Access to businesses, properties, and laneways will be maintained during rail delivery.


