

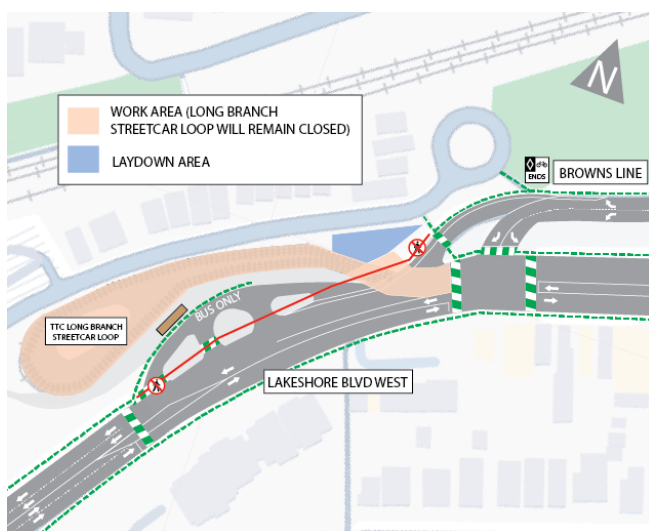
Essential track renewal at Long Branch Loop and the west intersection of Lake Shore Blvd West and Browns Line

Timeline: September 28 to October 18, 2026

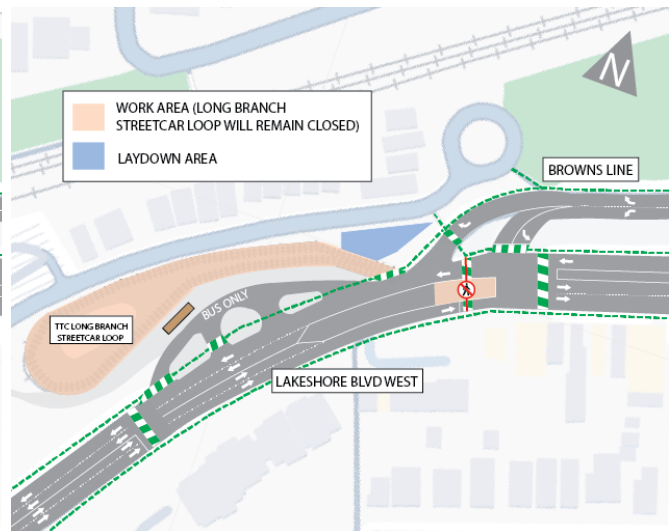

What we are doing and why

Beginning as early as on **Monday, September 28, 2026**, and continuing for approximately three (3) weeks, the TTC will be completing **Phase 2** and **Phase 3** of construction. To facilitate this work, lane reductions will be required at Lake Shore Boulevard West and Browns Line. One lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions, and all turn movements will be maintained. While streetcar service is suspended, TTC track crews will also be conducting essential rail and concrete repairs and overhead infrastructure upgrades at multiple streetcar stops along Lake Shore Boulevard West.

What activities, hours, and timeline

- **Phase 2:** TTC crews will replace tracks between Long Branch Loop and the west intersection of Lake Shore Blvd West and Browns Line. Work will begin as early as Monday, September 28, 2026, and is expected to be ongoing for approximately ten (10) days.
- **Phase 3:** TTC crews will replace the track in the west intersection of Lake Shore Blvd West and Browns Line. Phase 3 is expected to take approximately ten (10) days.
- Work activities will include concrete saw-cutting, concrete breaking/removal, rail replacement, and placement of new concrete. Concrete breaking/removal work will be conducted during the daytime.

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Construction Notice



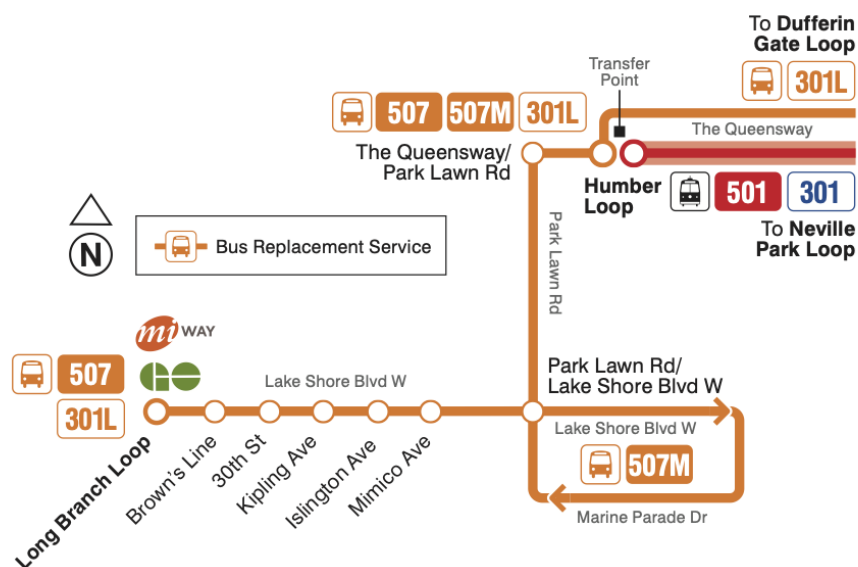
- Crews will aim to conduct noisy activities, such as concrete breaking/removal work, during the daytime; however, overnight work may be required due to unforeseen conditions or inclement weather.
- Some activities will be conducted **around-the-clock** to ensure the quality installation of new rail and concrete.
- Noise and lights from construction vehicles/machinery should be expected.

Motorist, cyclist, and pedestrian details

- Lane reductions will be required at Lake Shore Boulevard West and Browns Line. One lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions, and all turn movements will be maintained.
- Pedestrian and bicycle detours will be required. Signage will be in place to direct pedestrians around work zones.
- Pedestrian access to Long Branch *Bus* Loop will be maintained.
- A paid duty officers and/or flag persons will be on-site to help facilitate traffic movements.

TTC Service Changes (Began June 7, 2026) – Subject to Change*

- **507 Long Branch replacement buses** will continue to replace streetcars between Long Branch Loop and Humber Loop. Streetcars will continue to operate east of Humber Loop.
- Wheel-Trans service will be maintained.
