Monthly Construction Activities Schedule for Second Exit/Entrance

Construction Activity	Status

Restoration of Strathmore Blvd *Updated Restoration Plans sent to Neighbor's Counsel on February 27. *Utility relocations are scheduled to begin on April 24.	On-going

Utility Service Reinstatement – Overview

 Beginning the week of April 24, 2023, crews are scheduled to begin preparatory activities to complete the utility service relocation work for the second exit construction zone on Strathmore Boulevard. Notices were issued to impacted residents last week. Further details will be provided on the next phases of restoration.

Preparatory Works: Starting Monday April 24

Work activities:

- Crew will be removing the existing hoarding by the north side of the second exit construction site.
- A metal fence will be installed along the south side of the walkway until it is restored.
- A temporary gravel walkway will be implemented along the walkway.
- The temporary fire hydrants on Strathmore Boulevard will be removed.

Access restrictions:

The private walkways on the north side will have directional restrictions during each phase.
 Access to the homes will be maintained. Residents will be personally escorted to and from their homes.

Expected Duration:

• 5-10 days, pending weather.

Utility Service Reinstatement – Impacts

Water Service

Temporary water shut-offs may be required reconnect to the clay watermains. We will try
to provide as much notice as possible if a water shut off is deemed necessary. This may
only be known upon exposure of the connection point. Shut-offs will impact all addresses
in the second exit construction zone. Timing for the water shut-offs is to be confirmed by
Toronto Water.

North Side Access

 Access on the north side will be restricted during this time. Access to homes will be maintained.

Restoration – Next Steps

Enbridge Reinstatement Work

Enbridge will be in touch in the next couple weeks to schedule removal of the temporary
gas mains and reinstatement work for impacted homes. Access by Enbridge to each
property will be required for reinstatement work. No concrete cutting is expected for this
work. Work is expected to take one day at each address and begin May 8*.

Temporary Walkways

 The temporary walkway will be removed after utility work is completed. We will send a separate update about this work.

*All dates and timing are a projection, pending weather and unforeseen events.

Construction Impact Mitigation

Public use of north side of Strathmore

- Action taken: Currently security comes Thursday to Saturday overnight. They will continue to monitor the north walkway.
 Crossing guard at Donlands and Strathmore speaks to each person walking towards Strathmore to discourage trespassing.
 Toronto Fire and EMS did not support the option of locked gates – concerned about delays to emergency access and egress.
- TTC has added additional 'No Trespassing' signs to each walkway.
- TTC has distributed notices to the surrounding streets to help direct people around the neighbourhood and remind them of the private walkways.
- TTC has conducted spot checks to educate those using the walkway.
- TTC has sent all footage regarding porch thefts on Strathmore to TPS.





Construction Impact Mitigation

TPA Langford Lot

 Action taken: TTC remains in contact with the TPA to ensure maintenance of the parking lot and gate.

Track Repair Status

Action Taken: Track repairs identified by TTC operations have were completed March 1 and a follow-up inspection was taken at track level on March 21. One eastbound joint still requires further repairs and Community Relations has followed up with Track Maintenance.
