Temporary TTC service changes: from September 16 to October 5, 2024 *Content/timeline accurate at the time of printing


The City of Toronto and TTC recently completed watermain replacement and streetcar track renewal work on King Street West from Dufferin Street to Shaw Street.

TTC crews are completing the required commissioning/testing work to allow streetcars to travel safely along the newly constructed tracks.

TTC service on King Street West from September 16 to October 5, 2024

While TTC crews restore power to the overhead wiring and test the newly built streetcar tracks on King Street West, the 63 Ossington bus, which has been diverting around the construction area since earlier this year, will provide temporary service from **September 16 to October 5**.

• 63 Ossington buses will divert both ways via Atlantic Avenue, King Street West to route as follows:
