



## Old Mill Station Easier Access Project Commencement of Construction

### Timeline:

**Work to make Old Mill Station accessible will begin as early as March 2025\***

### What we are doing and why:

The TTC's Easier Access Program is making subway stations accessible. The TTC will commence work at Old Mill Station to make it accessible with two new elevators – scheduled to be in service in 2029\*.

The overall project will be conducted in stages. Construction will begin as early as March 2025\*.

The project will create a barrier-free path from the main entrance to all levels of the station, including installation of:

- Two elevators to provide a barrier-free pathway from the street level to the eastbound and westbound platforms
- Improved signage throughout the station
- Repaired finishes and installation of tactile attention tiles
- CCTV security cameras along the accessible pathway

### Construction will start with the following activities:

- The contractor's trailer and TTC trailer will be set up on TTC property/North side of the station.
- The contractor will set up construction hoarding to safely separate pedestrians and vehicles from the construction area.
- The pedestrian pathway from 39 Old Mill Road leading to Old Mill Station will remain open. The sidewalk within the construction area at 2662 Bloor Street West will be closed.
- Access to Old Mill Station will be maintained for customers throughout construction.
- Construction vehicles will access the Old Mill Easier Access construction site from Old Mill Trail and Bloor Street West via Breezeway.
- Signage to direct traffic will be placed.
- Construction trucks, equipment, and site staff will be present in the area.
- TTC buses will run regularly at Old Mill Station.
- No impacts to subway service on Line 2 – Bloor Danforth.
- The 2662 Bloor Street visitors' parking spots within the construction area will not be available for the duration of construction.
- The visitor parking spots outside the construction zone will be available.
