

St Clair Avenue West - State of Good Repair Projects Buses to replace streetcars as early as September 3, 2023

Infrastructure Renewal Overview

As part of TTC's work to modernize the system, overhead power upgrades must be implemented across the St Clair 512 streetcar route. Work will be coordinated with infrastructure renewal projects inside both St Clair and St Clair West Stations starting September 3, 2023. TTC is coordinating its projects with third-party works (Metrolinx, City of Toronto, and Toronto Water) planned in this area.

Work will require full bus replacement on the 512 St Clair streetcar route starting as early as September 3, 2023. Details on this and other service changes during construction can be found in the diagrams below.



Construction Notice



Transit service changes:

- As of September 3, 2023, if travelling between Gunns Road and St Clair Station, customers board buses along St. Clair Avenue (curbside).
- The 33 Forest Hill and 126 Christie buses can be boarded on St Clair Ave. West in front of St Clair West Station main entrances.
- The extension of 47A Lansdowne will be discontinued as of September 3, 2023.
- At St Clair Station, customers can access 512 buses at street-level.
- 90 Vaughan bus service will be extended to Bathurst Station starting September 3, 2023.
- Signage will be in place for all transit service changes. For latest information on service changes, please visit our website.

What to expect during construction work:

- The majority of work will take place between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m.
- Some overnight and weekend work will be required for safety purposes.
- Some noise, dust and, vibration associated with construction at stations is unavoidable with this work. Efforts will be made to minimize.
- Related streetcar infrastructure upgrade work will occur on the streetcar right of way and sidewalks.
- Minor overhead power upgrade work will occur near existing streetcar infrastructure along the route (near loops, poles, pits and substations).
- Utility relocation will begin in St Clair station as early as September 2023. This work is limited to the concourse level and will not impact transit service. However, hoarding within the station will result in reduced width of the passenger flow corridor. Appropriate signage will be in place.
- Crews will also be renewing the track and other streetcar infrastructure at St.Clair West Station along with upgrading other streetcar operations infrastructure in Fall 2023.
- With the bus replacement service, there is an expectation of increased traffic congestion as the buses will be travelling within mixed traffic.
- Construction trucks, equipment, and workers will be present in near the stations.
- Taxi stands and some bike parking adjacent to bus stops will be temporarily removed or relocated if possible.
- TTC will provide construction updates regularly throughout construction.
