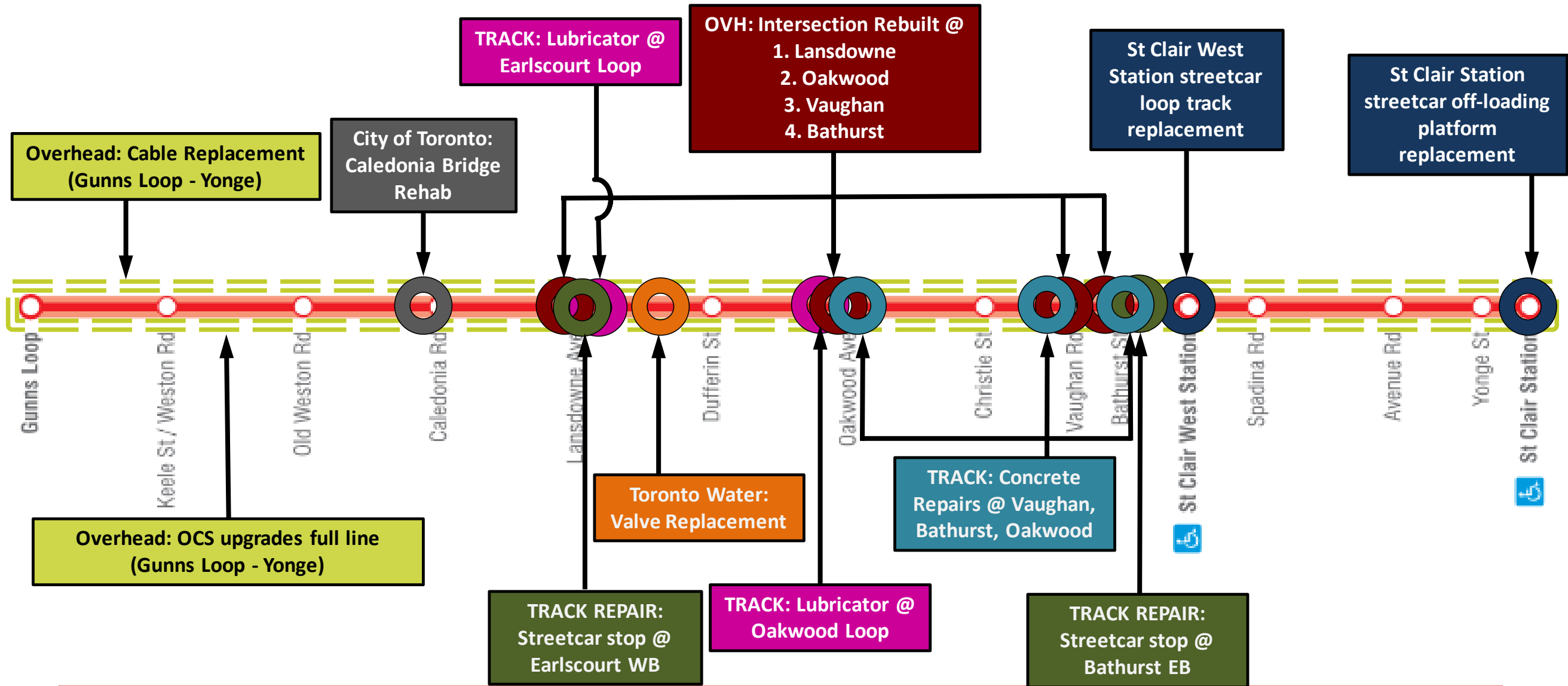

Overview

- Coordinating key state of good repair (SOGR) and station improvement projects to improve streetcar service reliability long term
- Streetcar overhead power upgrades for 512 St Clair (Right of Way)
- Infrastructure renewal projects inside St Clair West Station and St Clair Station.
- Coordinating TTC projects with non-TTC third party works (Metrolinx, City of Toronto and Toronto Water) to minimize duration.
- Overhead power upgrade work along the route (near loops, poles, pits and substations).

Streetcars replaced with buses

512 St Clair



Effective September 3, 2023 until summer 2024

Streetcar service will be replaced with buses on the full route, to accommodate multiple construction projects.

Buses will arrive every few minutes, serving curbside stops.

At St Clair Station, buses will board on the upper-level streetcar loop.

Buses will divert to Bathurst Station

90 Vaughan

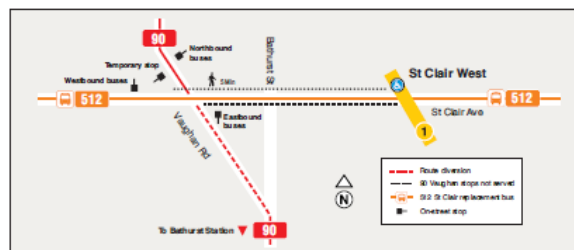


Effective September 3, 2023 until summer 2024

90 Vaughan will divert both ways to Bathurst Station, via Vaughan Road and Bathurst Street, due to track renewal.

To access Line 1 at St Clair West Station, southbound customers can use a temporary stop on Vaughan Road, north of St Clair Avenue, and walk approximately 5 minutes, or transfer to eastbound 512 St Clair replacement buses.

The northbound 90 Vaughan stop is on Vaughan Road, north of St Clair Avenue.

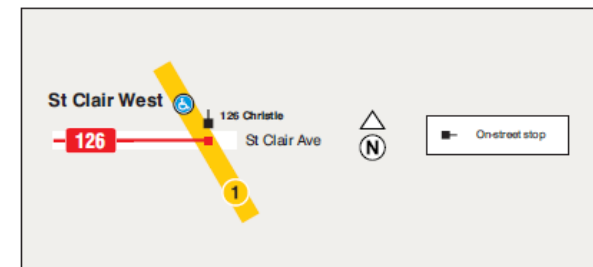
Buses will not enter St Clair West Station

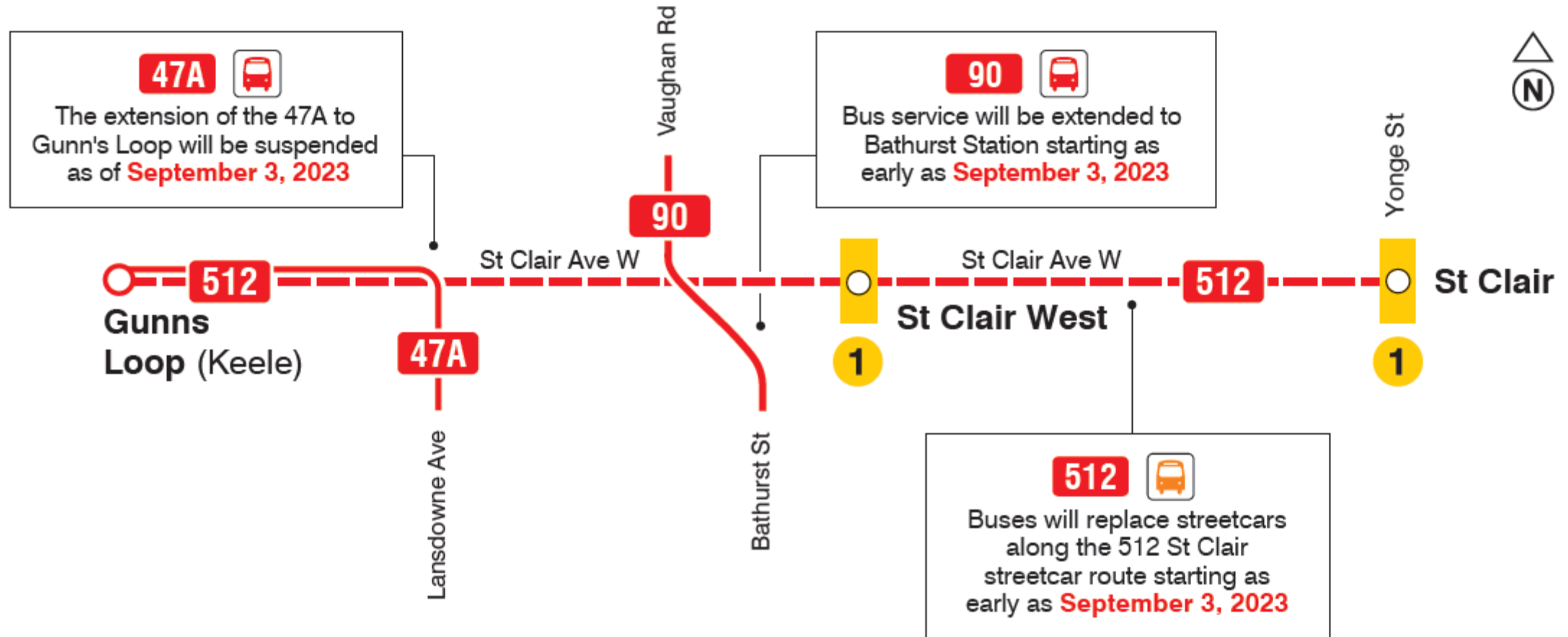
| 512 replacement bus service

- The service frequency for the 512 streetcar replacement buses will be approximately every **3 minutes (peak period)** during construction. 31 buses during peak period scheduled.
- The service frequency for the 512 streetcar replacement buses will be approximately every **6-10 minutes (off-peak period)** during construction.

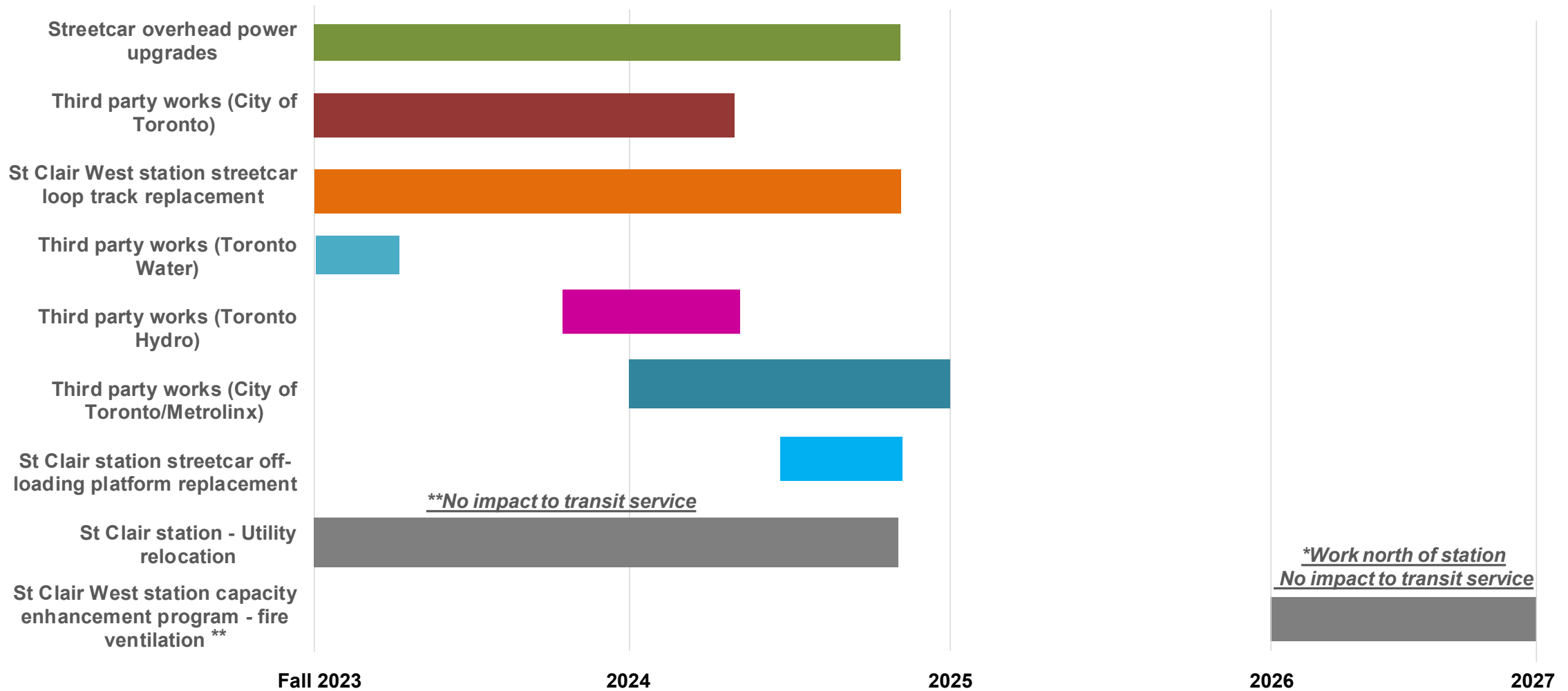

SCOPE:

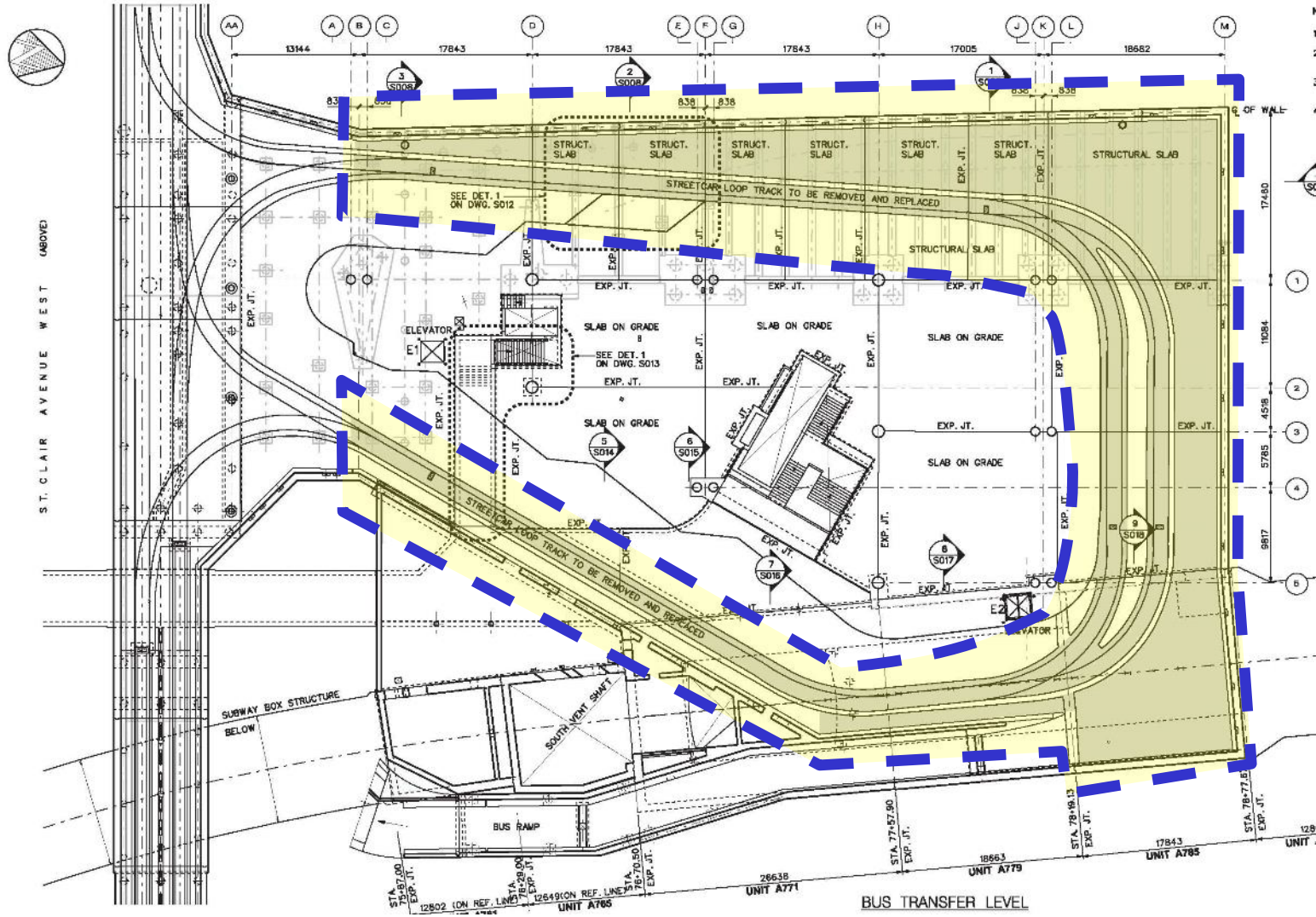
- **14,000 SQ. FT.** TOTAL EXCAVATION AREA
- **3,126 FT.** NEW RAIL/ RAIL REPLACEMENT
- **7 x** NEW TRACK DRAINS
- **4 x** NEW ELECTRIFIED SWITCHES
- **4 x** NEW MANUAL SWITCHES
- **4 x** NEW LUBRICATOR FRAMES
- **16 x** NEW CASTINGS

Note: Structural expansion joint upgrades is a major element of the loop work.

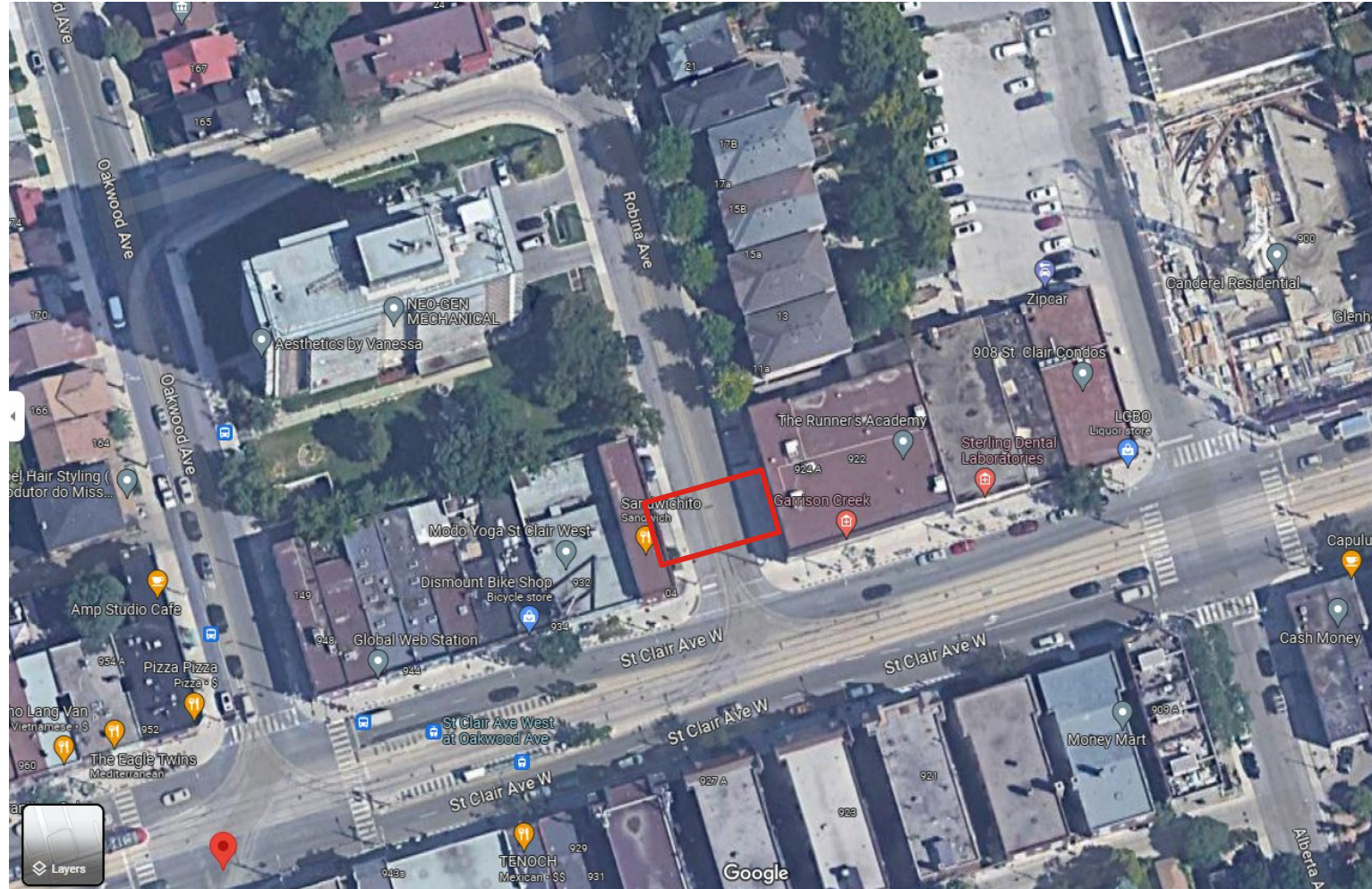

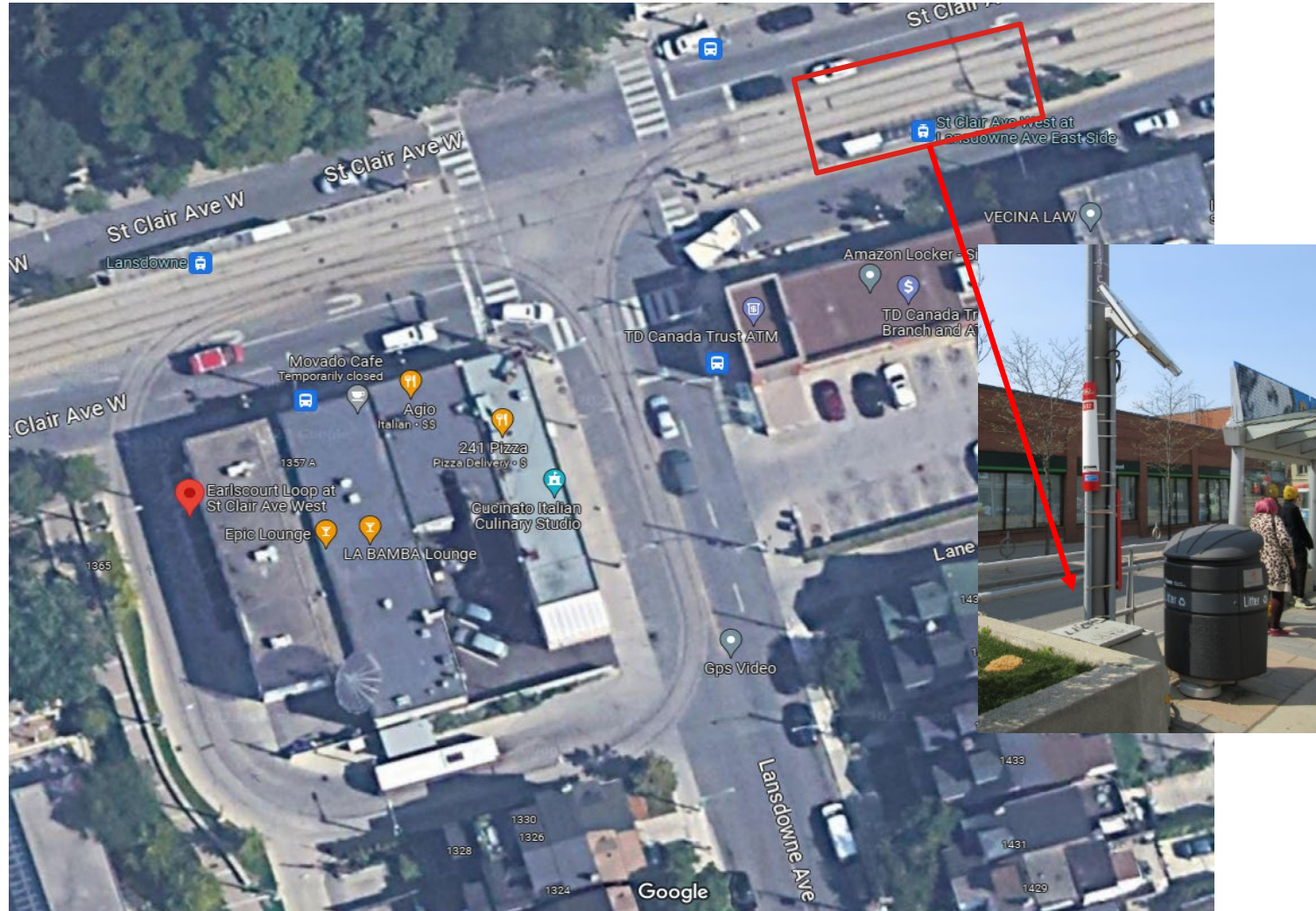

TRACK: Lubricator improvements OAKWOOD LOOP



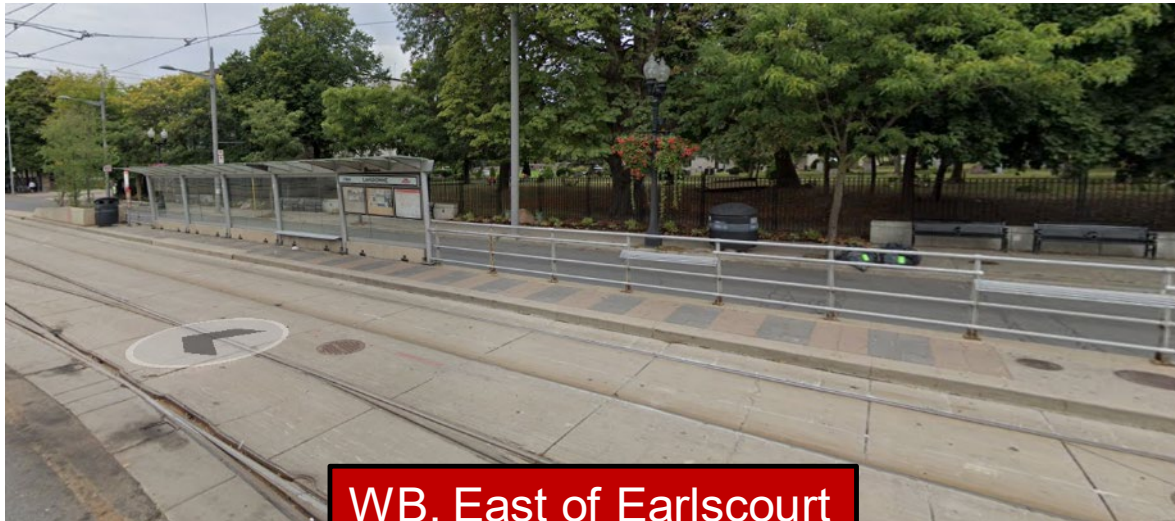
TRACK: Lubricator improvements EARLSCOURT LOOP



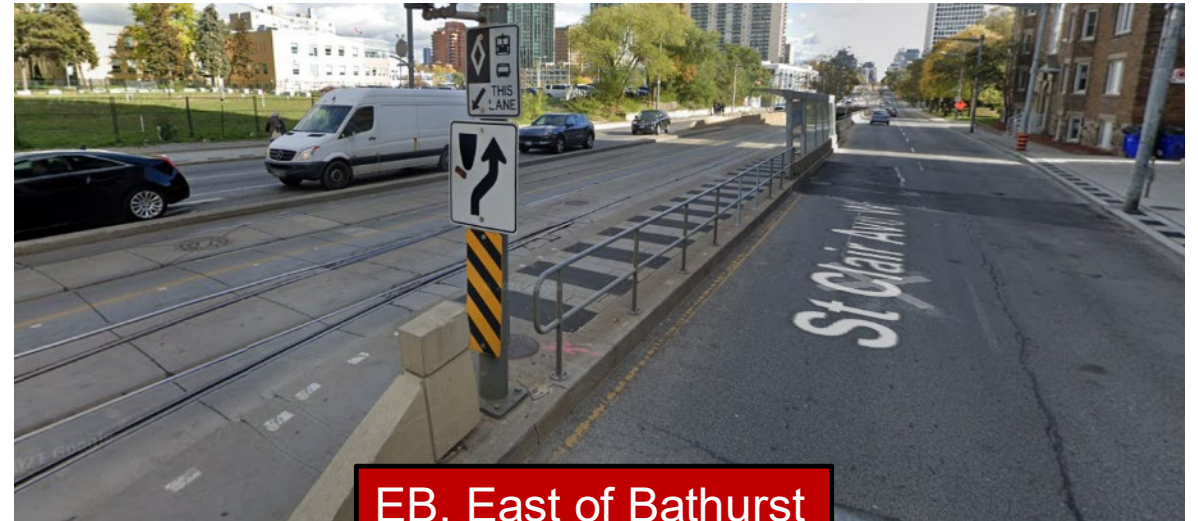
TRACK: Streetcar stops EARLSCOURT & BATHURST

SCOPE:

Concrete milling and excavation, rail replacement (including final welds) and infill restoration.



WB. East of Earls Court



EB. East of Bathurst

TRACK: Concrete Repair Work VARIOUS LOCATIONS

SCOPE:

Repairs to concrete along right-of-way.

- **St. Clair and Vaughan:**
 - 4 bays of track allowance
 - 6 bays of margin
 - some locations required asphalt during temporary joint repair work
- **St. Clair and Bathurst:**
 - 25' margin WB
- **Oakwood Loop:**
 - 3 bays + 1 bay devil strip
 - 2 bays inside the loop heaved

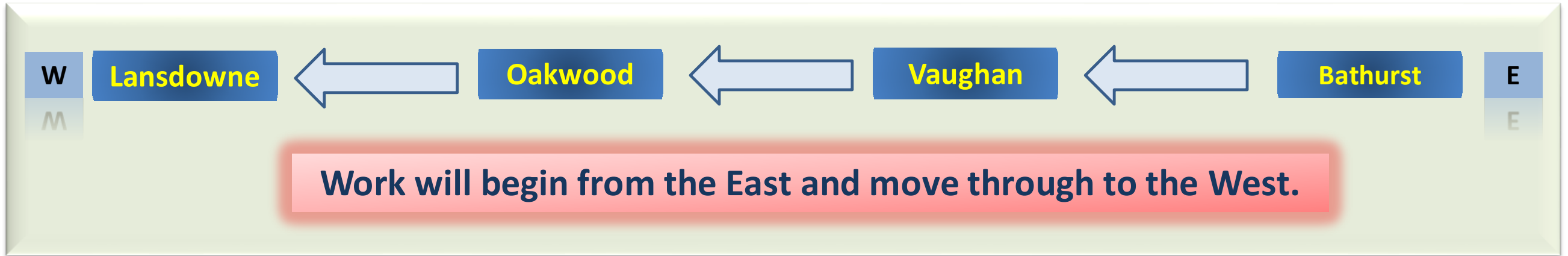
SCOPE:

- Installation and reinforcing of traction power cable to allow additional flexibility
- Work allows for easier/improved service turn backs at streetcar loops
- Repairs to chamber walls and covers

City of Toronto Bridge Rehabilitation Project CALEDONIA PARK ROAD

SCOPE:

The City of Toronto is carrying out a major construction project for the construction of the Caledonia bridge and thus, the overhead system has to be removed temporarily.

This is necessary to ensure the safety of people during the construction work and to ensure that the bridge is built to the highest standards.

TIMELINE:

Expected to begin in September 2023

Toronto Water Emergency Valve Replacements GREENLAW AVE.

SCOPE:

Two water main valves are broken (off position), and need to be replaced. They are located in TTC track margin. In order to excavate wide enough for valve install, part of the westbound TTC track base and track need to be removed. The excavation depth is around 2 meters. *Track reconstruction (by SCI Track) will be required due to excavation activities.*

Removal of OCS for this work could limit ability to upgrade Self-Tensioners

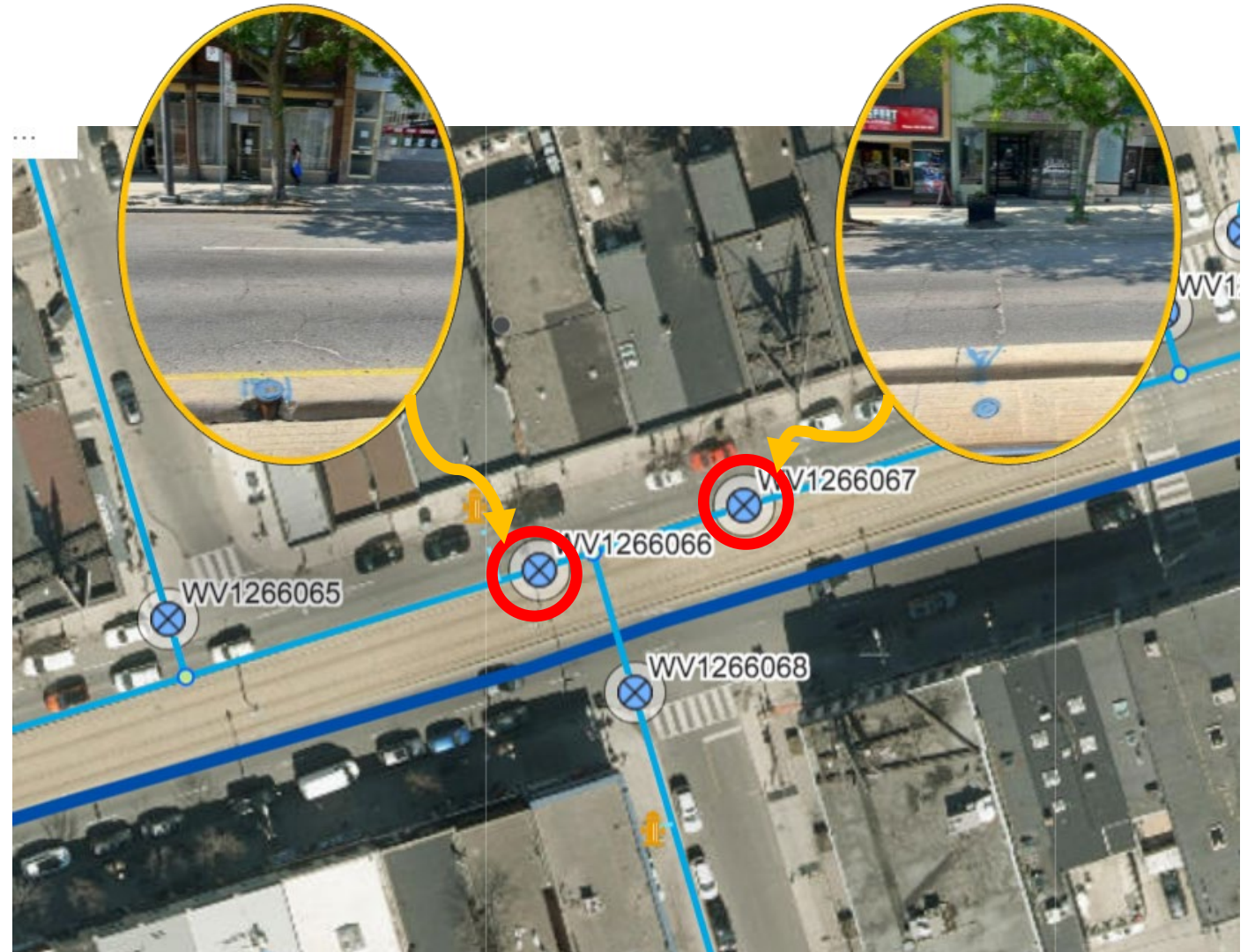

| Local BIAs, businesses & CaféTO

- CafeTO patios remain in place until the end of the 2023 CafeTO season.
- Access to paid parking lots along St. Clair Avenue will remain available.
- Updates will be provided during station construction.



Changes to keep transit and traffic moving

- TTC will review the bus service and coordinate with City Transportation and TPA to remove parking in pinch points identified following the CafeTO season.
- Signal modifications will be made along the St. Clair corridor to improve transit and traffic flow.
- Modifications made to facilitate bus use of the centre ROW where feasible following completion of overhead work.
