

# **Summerhill Station Easier Access Pre-Construction Update**

## **Easier Access – Program Wide**

- TTC's Easier Access Program will make all subway stations accessible to everyone.
- The TTC supports the goals of the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act (AODA), 2005 and the Ontario Human Rights Code and is committed to providing equal treatment and equitable benefits of the TTC services, programs and facilities in a manner that respects the dignity and independence of people with disabilities.
- TTC works with the Advisory Committee on Accessible Transit on effective design.
- 53 Stations are currently accessible.

## **Advisory Committee on Accessible Transit**

- The Advisory Committee on Accessible Transit (ACAT) are a group of Toronto citizens who advise the TTC on removing accessibility barriers and improving the customer experience for persons with disabilities and seniors.
- One of the committee's responsibilities is to inform the standards and objectives for TTC's Accessibility Plan.

#### **Easier Access Projects & ACAT**

 ACAT advises the TTC on priority and plans for Easier Access projects. All stations must have elevator access at the main station entrance to provide a direct, equitable accessible connection to destinations at street level.



#### **Easier Access at Summerhill Station**

 Two elevators will be installed at Summerhill Station to access both the northbound and southbound Line 1 subway platforms.

 A building extension and new main entrance will be constructed at the east end of the station to accommodate elevators and accessible design features including automatic sliding doors and accessible fare gates.

Elevators are scheduled to be in service by 2024.


Summerhill Station will also have a second exit/entrance which will be incorporated within a private development on Scrivener Square.




Rendering of new entrance at Summerhill Station looking north

#### **Summerhill Station – Elevation Plan**




#### **Summerhill Station – Accessible Path**



## What to expect during construction

- Dust, noise and vibration depending on the stage of work.
- Watermain relocation work.
- Delivery of construction material and equipment (from Yonge Street).
- Traffic impacts on Shaftesbury Avenue. TTC's contractor will work with City
  Transportation to implement a traffic management plan during each phase of
  construction to ensure access to driveways, waste collection and deliveries are
  maintained.
- Construction will typically occur between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. on weekdays, with some evening and weekend work when required.

## **TTC Commitment During Construction**

- Community Liaison to be single point of contact for the community
- Regular updates to individuals on the project mailing list
- Provide clear, accurate and timely information
- Provide regular updates on a dedicated page at projects.ttc.ca
- Maintain access to the station at all times
- Ensure contractor complies with local bylaws.
