



Warden Station – Easier Access Project & Station Redevelopment

Timeline: Starting Summer 2022

What we are doing and why

TTC's Easier Access Program will make subway stations accessible to everyone. This summer, work will start at Warden Station to create a barrier-free path from street level to subway platform level by 2024. In addition to accessibility, Warden Station is slated to be completely rebuilt, with an entirely new bus terminal featuring plenty of natural light and accessible bus platforms.

The station improvements will include:

- Two new elevators which will connect customers between the Passenger Pick Up/Drop Off area (PPUDO), concourse level and subway platform at the station.
- Improved signage and wayfinding throughout the station.
- Constructing a temporary accessible bus terminal which will begin service in 2024 and a new permanent accessible bus terminal, which will be completed in 2026.

Expected work activities

The first major phase of work will include shoring and excavation activities for the new elevator shafts within the existing station.

Project Timeline:

- **Summer 2022:** Construction will begin on the concourse and subway platform to install accessibility enhancements, including elevators.
- **Summer 2023:** Construction will begin to replace the existing south-lot with a temporary accessible bus terminal.
- **Winter 2024:** Warden Station fully accessible via completion of elevators and new temporary accessible bus terminal.
- **Fall 2026:** Completion of a new permanent accessible bus terminal at Warden Station.

Traffic and pedestrian details

- The existing South Commuter Lot will be replaced with a temporary, accessible bus terminal by the end of 2024. This work will impact 151 station parking spaces.
 - The South Commuter Lot will have 32 permanent short-term parking spaces remaining.



Work hours

Work will take place Monday to Friday between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. Some work on Saturdays between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. may be required to maintain schedule.

TTC service

Access to the station and subway platforms will be maintained throughout construction. Bus service will be maintained throughout construction at the temporary accessible bus platform.
