Lawrence Station – Temporary South **Entrance/Exit Closure**

Timeline: Starting July 8, 2024

What we are doing and why

The TTC is making stations accessible as part of the Easier Access program. This program includes the installation of elevators, accessible doors, and updated wayfinding signage to create a barrier-free path from street level to the subway platform. Starting July 8, until mid-2025, both south main entrance/exits at Lawrence Station located at Yonge and Lawrence will be closed to the public to accommodate ongoing work to install elevators at the station.

The Easier Access improvements will include

- Two new elevators which will connect customers from • the station entrance to the bus terminal and subway levels.
- New stairs from platform to concourse level of the station.
- Accessible sliding doors at the main entrance, and barrier free doors throughout station.
- Improved wayfinding and signage throughout the station.



Customer impact

Access to and from the station will only be available at the secondary north entrances on Yonge Street at Ranleigh Avenue and Bedford Park Avenue.

Service impact

- Customers may board routes 11C Bayview, 52G Lawrence West and 162 Lawrence-Donway on-street outside Lawrence Station at Lawrence Avenue and Yonge Street.
 - o **11C Bayview** has been extended Lawrence Avenue and Avenue Road. The route will continue to serve the Sunnybrook Hospital campus.
 - o 52G Lawrence West extends to Sunnybrook Hospital via Lawrence Avenue East and Bayview Avenue.
 - o **162 Lawrence-Donway** buses have been extended to Lawrence Avenue and Avenue Road.
- 52 Lawrence West and 952 Lawrence West Express continue to divert to Eglinton Station via Avenue Road and Eglinton Avenue West.

TTC service

Access to Lawrence station and subway platforms will be maintained throughout this phase of construction.
